

Summer Program Information

Summer PMO camps are intended for children already enrolled in our PMO program or children that will be attending PMO in the fall.

Updated immunizations are required to attend.

A full PMO enrollment package is required for summer camps.

PMO students ages 12 months—4 years old are eligible to attend.

Parents are responsible for providing a mid-morning snack, AND a lunch including beverages daily.

Each child needs to bring a backpack with a complete change of clothes daily.

Children should arrive with sunscreen and insect repellent already applied.

A non-refundable supply fee of \$45.00 per child is due at the time of registration.

**Tuition

Tuition is non-refundable, but is transferable to another week if a vacancy is available.

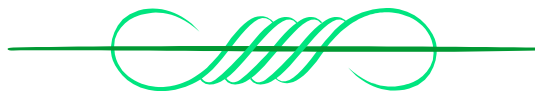
Weekly tuition cannot be split into individual days.

Children should come in casual clothing, including closed toe shoes with ankle strap and socks or sneakers and socks every day.

Children will be playing inside the classrooms, the gym and outside on the playground.

Sunscreen and insect repellent should be applied by parent upon arrival.

Children may be given ice-pops. If your child cannot consume colored pops, sweetened with sugar, corn syrup, etc., please bring substitutes for your child.

Updated immunizations provided

Summer PMO camps are intended for children already enrolled in our PMO program or children that will be attending PMO in the fall.

Parents/care givers are responsible for making reservations in the book at by Thursday morning for the following Tuesday morning attendance.

All other reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Payment is due in advance of attendance for the day.

Many activities will be in the outdoor classroom, so children must wear closed toe shoes with ankle strap AND socks or sneakers AND socks.

Children may be engaged in water activities.

Each child needs to have the following in his/her backpack/diaper bag:

- 2 complete changes of clothes
- Diapers/pull ups/underwear
- A towel
- A bag for wet clothing
- A sunhat
- Snacks
- Drinks
- Lunch

Teachers are not allowed to apply sunscreen or insect repellent, per Code of Virginia.

Parents/care givers are responsible for applying sunscreen and insect repellent. prior to attendance for the day.

Due to overwhelming demand, reservations may be limited based on staffing daily.
