Gross Motor:

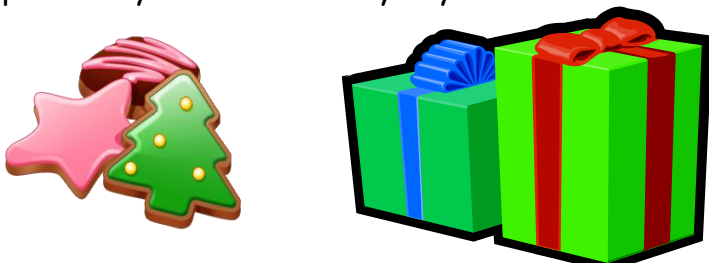
Music and Movement - We will be rehearsing our songs for the Christmas program.
