Learning Objectives:

We will introduce the Letter M in our "Letter Basket". We will talk about items that start with that letter sound such as: mittens, milk, money, monkey and music. We will review Letters A through L.

We will also start discussing the theme of Winter (this will carry over for the next few weeks) by talking about the 4 seasons and what you need to wear in the winter and what you can do in the winter. We will also be reading a selection of books by Jan Brett.

Math:

We will continue to review our numbers 1-10. Each child will be counting marbles as a one on one activity so we can assess how high they can count.
