What else begins with T?" Any opportunity you have -- point out letters and the sound it makes. "We're going to Farm Fresh today. What letter do you hear at the beginning of Farm and Fresh? What else begins with this sound?" Point out letters in books, magazines, signs - particularly lowercase letters. Anything you do to reinforce what we are learning in class will greatly benefit your child and get them ready to read.
