Music and Movement: The class will pretend to fly like a **b**umblebee while listening to “Flight of the **B**umblebee”. The children will listen to and act out “Going on a **B**ear Hunt”.

Gross Motor – The class will **b**uild and then walk on a low-to-the-ground **b**alance **b**eam.

Computer: The children will be playing the Living Book “The **B**erenstain **B**ears Get In A Fight”. Living Books are interactive stories that highlight the words as the pages of the story are being read, as well as allowing the children to click on images on the page, bringing the story to life.

Names: The children will continue to spell their names using magnetic letters, write their names on reusable name writing sheets, sort their classmates' photos into boy and girl categories and then match their classmates' nameplate to the correct photo. The class will create their names using tissue paper.

Science: The class will be making **b**ubbles by mixing dish soap and water. The children will be creating **b**inoculars and will be able to view the classroom through actual **b**inoculars. The class will mix orange and black paint to make **b**rown paint and then will use it to paint a **b**ear picture.

Math: The children will be placing the correct number of **b**ee magnets onto the corresponding **b**ear number math mats and will complete **b**ee mazes. The class will be sorting toy dinosaurs and stuffed animals into **B**ig and little categories. The children will be completing activities in the math bins for shapes and colors.

Art: The class will be creating pictures using bubble wrap and paint, a bear headband, bumblebee puppets, a bee bookmark, and bumblebees with their fingerprints.

Language Arts: The class will fill **Bb** using Light Bright pegs, this activity is wonderful for developing small motor skills. They will also complete **Bb** workbook pages.
