**Letter of the week: Mm**

**Math:** This week we will be graphing the children's answers to “all about me” questions such as; what is your favorite color?, have you lost a tooth?, are you left or right handed?, and what is your eye color? We will then compare and contrast the information presented in the graphs using the terms, “how many more than, least, greatest, same or equal to, greater, more, most, less, fewer, and smallest”. The children will also place the correct number of muffins on moose number math mats for numbers 1-20 and outline shapes with marshmallows. They will then be allowed to eat the marshmallows!

**Science:** The children will experiment with magnets learning what magnets will and will not “stick” to and use magnifying glasses to match tiny pictures to their corresponding large pictures. We will be discussing facts about Inuit Indians, Alaska, and moose. The class will create a weather wheel.

**Social Studies:** The class will be learning about manners and moods. After reading the classic story “Mama, Do You Love Me?” we will discuss the fact that parents and God love you even if you make a mistake.

**Language Arts:** Using sequencing cards, the children will sequence the events in the story, “If You Give A Moose A Muffin”. The children will be allowed to taste muffins! We will discuss vocabulary words from the story “Mama Do You Love Me” such as: mukluk, parka, puffin, umiak, etc. The class will also trace the ABC's using reusable learning mats and complete workbook pages for the letter Mm.

**Art:** The class will create happy and sad face puppets, a moose puppet out of a paper lunch bag, watercolor a moose and mickey mouse picture, paint with marshmallows, and fill a cut-out of a child with pictures that they cut from magazines of their favorite things.

**Listening Center:** Using headphones the class will listen to the story “I am Feeling Silly”.
